In Chamber Music, Arthur Kopit creates a world grounded upon two fundamental metaphors: chamber music-- the orchestration and interaction of single different instruments within a small room; and the asylum -- a metaphor conveying confinement, hopelessness, and piercing interpersonal action.

Chamber Music is a world of fiercely battling egos, hilarious in its whimsy and fantasy, yet terrifying in its resemblance to the tiny confining globe upon which we are all trapped: a world in which the cardinal virtue lies in keeping in step, and in helping one another to believe we really ARE as important as we believe we are. The capital sin lies in questioning the reality of another's world -- view on the value or rationality of the whole effort.

Is Amelia Earhart the real one, or is she madder than the rest? Are we sane and the rest of the world mad? Are we all locked helplessly in an asylum together? Are we eternally doomed to kill one another for the most righteous of justifications and the most mad of reasons?

Kopit has couched these questions, at least in part, in comedy. Let us laugh while we may.
